Principles

At Manor Church of England Infant School:

- we aim to ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of the pupils;
- pupil premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis.

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2013/14 was: £15848
(£15248 Ever 6, £600 Service children).

This amount was targeted to:

- a) provide one:one for targeted Maths or English interventions where required;
- b) continue to provide access to our Parent Support Advisor to offer a range of support to pupils and their families including transition between schools;
- c) fund school uniform;
- d) provide ELSA sessions;
- e) provide one:one support in class for pupils including additional support with phonics and reading;
- f) subsidise children for after school sports clubs;
- g) fund eligible individuals for Early Bird Club sessions;
- h) additional staffing;
- i) Educational Psychologist training on specific interventions for Teaching Assistants.

The impact of the PPG for 2013/14 was:

- a) Improved rates of progress, self esteem, raised confidence.
- b) Improved attendance.
- c) Inclusion.
- e) Improved rates of progress with phonics.
- f) Improved pupil participation in after school clubs.
- g) Improved attendance and punctuality at school.
- h) Greater ability to deliver small group and 1:1 interventions.
- i) Trained support staff able to deliver specific interventions accurately.

Where next?

- Specific 1:1 timetable of intervention in place for each PP child focusing on a target area eg phonics, reading, writing, Maths.
- Funded place for an additional ELSA to attend the EP led ELSA support groups on a termly basis.
