What's it all about?



In this topic your child will learn to talk about holidays in the past and present.

The topic will start with the children sharing their Travel Journals.



Curriculum Focus:

History: Seaside holidays 100 years ago

Children will be:

- identifying artefacts.
- learning how holidays have changed over time.

Geography: Seaside places in the United Kingdom

Children will be:

- locating places on a map.
- describing the human and physical features of places.

D.T: Designing and making a puppet

Children will be:

- joining fabric by sewing.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have learnt, the children will be able to talk about holidays in the past and present.



Ways to support your child at home:

- ❖ Visit the beach and talk about the things you can see.
- ❖ Find out about a Grandparent's holiday in the past.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to:

- ❖ In English children will be learning how to write postcards and captions.
- ❖ In Maths children will be learning to recognise numbers to 50, counting 1:1 and adding.
- ❖ In R.E. children will be identifying and talking about 'Special Clothes'.
- ❖ In Art children will be using collage to create work in the style of Andy Goldsworthy.
- ❖ In I.C.T. children will be learning to keep our information private and we will be understanding and using the term 'algorithm'.
- ❖ In P.E. children will be taking part in team games and learning how to improve gymnastics techniques.
