What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to talk about
Hobury and how the area has changed.

The topic will start with a Geography 'Eye Spy'
walk around Hobury.



Curriculum Focus:

In Geography children will learn to:

- describe the area of Hobury and how it has changed.
- use maps to gather information and create their own.

In Art: children will:

- use painting to develop art work of Hobury.

In Computing children will:

- create and debug simple programmes using the Beebots.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have
learnt, the children will be able to talk about
Hobury and how the area has changed.

Ways to support your child at home:

- ❖ In your 'Travel Journal' write about a local visit e.g. a walk to the park.
- ❖ Use the internet to find features of Holbury.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to:

In English: Children will write non-chronological reports, re-tell traditional tales and create Christmas poems.

In Maths: Children will work with numbers to 50, adding and subtracting, and know the number bonds to 10 and 20.

In R.E.: Children will learn about why Christmas is important to Christians.

In Science: Children will learn about different materials and their properties.

In P.E.: Children will create and perform simple dances and develop their throwing and catching skills.

In Music : Children will be learning how to play tuned percussion.

The children will go for a walk around Holbury looking for different geographical features.
