Jobs in the Locality

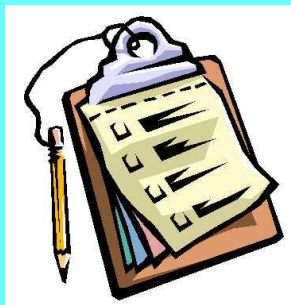

What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to find out information about jobs in Holbury.

The topic will start with questionnaires about people's jobs in your family.



Curriculum Focus:

In Geography children will learn to:

- gather information about jobs in Holbury.
- use information to discuss changes to the locality.

In Art: children will:

- use new media to create an image of Holbury.

In D.T. children will:

- design and build a winding mechanism.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have learnt, the children will be able to discuss jobs in Holbury.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to:

In English children will write instructions and stories.

In Maths children will learn to recognise numbers up to 100, develop their confidence with adding and subtracting, use simple multiplication and develop an understanding of division as sharing.

In R.E. children will understand the term 'change' and relate it to their own lives. The children will listen to stories about Jesus changing people in the Bible.

In P.E. children will be developing co-ordination with ball skills as well as their reaction and response skills.
