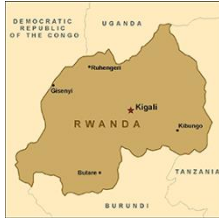

What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to discuss the features of Rwanda and compare Rwanda to Holbury.

The topic will start with a mystery object sent to the children. The challenge will be to find out what it is and how it is used.



Curriculum Focus:

Geography: -

- We will be learning about Rwanda.
- We will be learning how to make observations.
- We will compare Rwanda to Holbury.

D.T. -

- We will be designing and making an information poster using levers and sliders.

Art: -

- We will be looking at different types of printing and creating our own prints.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have learnt, the children will be able to talk about the country of Rwanda and discuss the culture.

Ways to support your child at home:

In English: We will write reports to inform and discussions to persuade.

In Maths: We will recognise numbers to 75, add and subtract using number lines, continue to count in steps of 2 and 10.

In Science: We will explore different plants and find out what they need to grow.

In R.E.: We will explain when we feel sad then happy.

In P.E.: We will develop coordination through balls skills, counter balance and invasion games.
