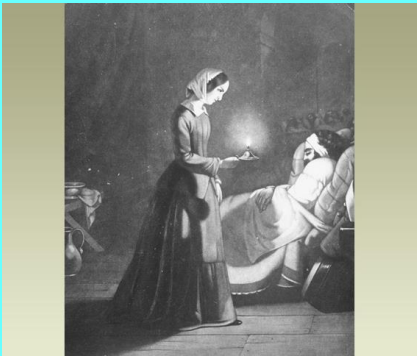
Lady with the Lamp

What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to sequence and discuss significant events in the life of Florence Nightingale.

The topic will start with a history quiz - 20 questions about a photo.



Curriculum Focus:

In **History** children will:

- sequence significant events from the life of Florence Nightingale.
- learn how to use a variety of sources to gather information.



In **Computing** children will:

- create a book about Florence Nightingale using a computer programme.

In **Art** children will:

- learn how to create different self-portraits.

Outcome:

The children will be able to discuss the life of Florence Nightingale and remember significant events in her life.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to do the following:

In **English**: to write stories to entertain and describe real events about Florence Nightingale.

In **Maths**: to recognise numbers to 100, to add, subtract, use simple multiplication and understand sharing as division.



In **R.E.**: to understand the term 'change' and relate it to their own lives. The children will listen to stories about Jesus changing people in the Bible.

In **P.E.**: to develop his/her co-ordination when using equipment and to use agility skills in order to react and respond.

In **P.S.H.E.** the children will be learning how to keep safe.

In **Science** the children will explore different materials.

- ❖ Make an information poster about the life of Florence Nightingale.
- ❖ Visit the grave of Florence Nightingale at St Margaret's Church in Wellow near Romsey.
