What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to ...

Curriculum Focus:

In Geography children will learn to:

- describe the area of Holbury and how it has changed.
- use maps to gather information and create their own.

In Art: children will:

- use painting to develop art work of Holbury.

In Computing children will:

- learn to programme Beebots with a series of instructions to perform several actions.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have
learnt, the children will...

be able to talk about Holbury and how
the area has changed.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to:

In English: Children will write reports about Holbury, as well as stories and poems to entertain.

In Maths: Children will use and recall multiplication and division facts using the 2 and 10 times tables.



In R.E.: Children will discuss the importance of angels in the Christmas story.

In P.E.: Children will create and perform simple dances and develop their throwing and catching skills.

In Music: Children will use voice to practise and perform our Christmas Performance.

- ❖ Use the internet to find features of Holbury.
