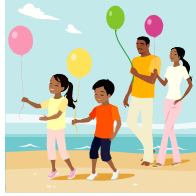

What's it all about?



In this topic your child will learn to talk about holidays in the past and present.

The topic will start with the children sharing their holiday experiences.



Curriculum Focus:

History: Seaside holidays 100 years ago

Children will be:

- identifying artefacts.
- learning how holidays have changed over time.

Geography: Seaside places in the United Kingdom

Children will be:

- locating places on a map.
- describing the human and physical features of places.

D.T.: Designing and making a puppet

Children will be:

- joining fabric by sewing.

Outcome:

At the end of the topic to show what we have learnt, the children will be able to talk about holidays in the past and present.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to:

In English the children will be learning how to write letters and reports.

In Maths the children will learn to add and subtract on their own number line; to read and write numbers to 100.

In R.E. the children will be identifying and talking about key events in Jesus' life.

In Art the children will use collage to create work in the style of Andy Goldsworthy.

In I.C.T. the children will be learning how to be E-Safe and how to ask different types of questions.

In P.E. the children will learn how to improve gymnastics techniques and games tactics.

In P.S.H.E. the children will be learning how to recognise and celebrate differences.

In Science the children will be investigating the properties of materials.

In Music the children will be learning how to play tuned percussion instruments.
