be able to discuss the main features of Coll and compare it to Holbury.

In English: Children will write stories including Katie Morag and reports about the island of Coll.

In Maths: Children will use and recall multiplication and division facts using the 5 times tables, and solve problems using money.



In R.E.: Children will apply the concept 'special' to books.

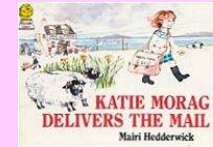
In P.E.: Children will be using dynamic and static balances.
