What's it all about?

In this topic your child will learn to sequence and discuss significant events in the life of Florence Nightingale.

The topic will start with a history quiz
- 20 questions about a photo.



Curriculum Focus:

In **History** children will:

- sequence significant events from the life of Florence Nightingale.
- learn how to use a variety of sources to gather information.

In **Computing** children will:

- learn how to gather and use information from given internet sites.

In **Art** children will:

- create self-portraits.

Outcome:

The children will be able to discuss the life of Florence Nightingale and remember significant events in her life.

In addition to the topic based learning outlined above, your child will also be learning to do the following:

In English the children will learn to describe real events and write to persuade.

In Maths the children will further develop an understanding of place value to 100 and secure all calculations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In R.E. the children will develop their own ideas about God and will be learning about Christian and Hindu ideas about God.

In P.S.H.E. the children will be learning about how to create positive friendships.

In Music the children will be learning to play 'Bamboo Tamboo'.

In Science the children will be learning about plants and their lifecycles.

In P.E. the children will develop co-ordination when using equipment and will develop agility skills in order to react and respond quickly.

Ways to support your child at home:

- ❖ Find and discuss interesting facts about Florence Nightingale.
- ❖ Make an information poster about the life of Florence Nightingale.
- ❖ Visit the grave of Florence Nightingale at St Margaret's Church in Wellow near Romsey.
- ❖ Complete weekly Maths homework.
- ❖ Read 3 times a week with your child.
- ❖ Practise weekly spellings.
