Year 1 Phonics Test

As some of you may be aware, all Year 1 children across the country will



take part in the Phonics Screening Checks during the week beginning 12th June. The check is a short, statutory assessment to ensure that children are making sufficient progress in the phonics skills to read words and are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. Mrs Welling will be carrying out the checks on a one to one basis with each child. The check will take no longer than ten minutes. The results of the check will be shared with parents at the end of the summer term.

School Council Competition

Attendance Update

Hampshire County
Council has recently
reminded schools of
their roles and



responsibilities regarding unauthorised absences. The Code of Conduct (Sept 2015) states that a Penalty Notice can be issued where there have been 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence in any 100 sessions (50 school days). Currently, if paid within 21 days, a penalty notice comes with a fine of £60 per parent, per child. If the fine is not paid within 28 days







the penalty is automatically increased to £120. If the fine remains unpaid then the next step is court proceedings. The fine itself is paid to Hampshire County Council, not to individual schools. Therefore, if you request a leave of absence for a holiday for 5 days or more, under this guidance, you will be issued with a penalty notice.

We understand and sympathise with parents' frustration at the increased cost of taking holidays in school holidays. School staff are also subject to the higher prices.

Should you require another copy of the Code of Conduct, it is available from the school office.

At Manor we highlight to children the importance of good attendance. Every week we present our attendance bear to the class with the best



attendance. At the end of every term we present certificates to children who have achieved 100% attendance for the term.

By making sure that your child has good attendance at school you are helping them to:

- Get the best possible chance of a successful education.
- Maintain good social and emotional relationships.
- Achieve their best in their learning to enable them to reach their full potential.
- Set a pattern of behaviour which will be beneficial throughout their life.
