<p>What could we do to improve our school to make it even better?</p> <p>Make it a primary school. I miss parents to lunch week. It helps unconfident eaters. More homework. Better reading books, current ones are dated. A very structured day and a lack of afternoon play makes a very long afternoon of learning. Homework is limited, issued with short notice and infrequently, no penalty for not doing the homework. Would like to see routine homework in preparation for year 2. Make sure that everyone is on the same page with regards to rules including the adults. Create a general after school club run until after 5pm. Allow siblings in to breakfast club. More information on what the children are learning. The Maths sheet has been useful.</p>
