

**Manor CE Infant School**  
**School Improvement Priorities 2017-18**



**Rationale: In order to improve the education provided by our school we will be focusing on improving the following areas:**

**Outcomes for pupils:**

- 1) For 85%+ of children in Year 2 to be at age related expectations (ARE) by June 2018.
- 2) For the school to meet or exceed the national percentage of children achieving Greater Depth in Year 2 for combined reading, writing and Maths.
- 3) To reduce the number of children working below ARE.

**Quality of Leadership and management:**

- 1) For all leaders at all levels to further develop their impact on raising standards in teaching and learning.
- 2) To develop the outdoor learning space in EYFS so that it mirrors that inside.
- 3) To ensure that the Pupil Premium, Sports and SEN funding delivers good outcomes for pupils.
- 4) Governors carry out their strategic role in holding leaders to account.

**Quality of teaching, learning and assessment:**

- 1) To secure consistent, high quality learning intentions so that children know what they need to achieve in each lesson and how to improve.
- 2) For middle leaders to provide coaching in order to improve the quality of teaching and ensure rapid progress for 'close to' and 'more able' children.
- 3) To further develop the quality of writing (particularly for boys).

**Personal development, behaviour and welfare:**

- 1) To increase attendance to 96%.
- 2) To ensure that safeguarding procedures are effective and that all new staff know how to safeguard children and take appropriate actions if necessary.
- 3) Curriculum provision is effective in ensuring that children feel safe at all times.
